Clinical Pharmacology

Trisha Dowling, DVM, MSc, DACVIM, DACVCP
4 hours scientific CE

Trisha Dowling graduated DVM, Cum Laude from Texas A&M University in 1987. She received her M.S. in Large Animal Medicine and Surgery from Auburn University, Alabama in 1993. She is a Diplomate of both the ACVIM and the ACVP. She has served as Director of Canadian gFARAD (Canadian global food animal residue avoidance databank) from 2001-present. She has been awarded several times for teaching and leadership, including the Gwenna Moss Centre for Teaching Effectiveness award as a Teaching and Learning Scholar (2009), and the Norden Distinguished Teacher award. She has coauthored 2 textbooks – Antimicrobial Therapy in Veterinary Medicine 4th Ed (2007), and Handbook of Veterinary Drugs 3rd Ed. (2004), written 40 book chapters, published 47 peer reviewed scientific papers and 20 review papers.

Hepatic Disease

Sharon Center, DVM, DACVIM
6 hours scientific CE

Dr. Center received her undergraduate (BS) in Biological Sciences at California State University, and her veterinary training at the University of California at Davis. She completed a rotating Internship in Small Animals and Residency in Internal Medicine at the New York State College of Veterinary Medicine, Cornell University, Ithaca, NY. She joined the veterinary faculty at Cornell in 1983 and is currently a Professor of Internal Medicine. Currently she co-manages the Internal Medicine referral service, provides didactic lectures in the areas of hepatobiliary and hematologic disease to 3rd and 4th year veterinary students, trains Small Animal Internal Medicine residents, and conducts focused research in the area of canine and feline hepatobiliary disorders, including disease characterization, diagnostic evaluations, and therapeutic interventions. She has authored many research manuscripts, clinical papers, and book chapters regarding liver disease in dogs and cats and is currently participating in studies to better characterize the chronic hepatitis syndromes in dogs and cats.

Cardiology Pearls

Kim Hawkes, DVM, ACVIM Cardiology Board Candidate
2 hours scientific CE

Dr. Kim Hawkes joined the Western Veterinary Specialist Centre full-time in September of this year. She joins them from the Ontario Veterinary College at the University of Guelph, where she recently completed her clinical component of her cardiology specialty training. After graduating from WCVM in 2000, Kim spent four years in private practice in Edmonton. She then went on to complete a small animal rotating surgical and medical internship at the Virginia-Maryland Regional College of Veterinary Medicine in Blacksburg, Virginia. Kim is looking forward to continuing to build the cardiology service at WVSC, and hoping to have a full-service catheterization suite within the next year. Kim's research has focused on advanced echocardiographic methods of assessing cardiac function. Her areas of special interest include interventional cardiology, advanced echocardiographic assessment of systolic and diastolic function, arrhythmogenic right ventricular cardiomyopathy, and canine dilated cardiomyopathy.
