# Responsible Reporting: Recognizing Distress in Your Patients & When to Report

**Speakers:** Margaret Doyle (DVM, BSc MVB MSc MRCVS, Forensic Veterinarian), CPO Sabrina Bergin & Olivia Rogiani

This course will help you recognize signs of distress in your patients and help you to navigate your responsibility in reporting suspected abuse cases under the Animal Protection Act.

### Speaker Biography:

Dr. Margaret Doyle graduated from the University College Dublin in 2009. She began working with animal protection officers from the Calgary Humane Society in 2010 and has since completed a Masters in Veterinary Forensics through the University of Florida. She currently consults with multiple law enforcement agencies in Alberta on animal abuse and neglect files and focuses on improving inter-agency cooperation. Dr. Doyle has worked on hundreds of cases, from crime scene analysis to necropsies to providing expert witness testimony at trial. She is passionate about increasing the awareness of the connection between animal abuse and domestic and interpersonal violence as a means to combat violence of all kinds in society.

**Sabrina Bergin** convocated in 2004 from the University of Alberta with a BA in History and Political Science then went on to complete a 2 year Grant MacEwan Police Studies program in 2006. She has been working for the past 11 years as a member with the City of Edmonton Animal Control.

**Olivia Rogiani** worked for the City as a Municipal Enforcement Officer prior to working with the City of Edmonton Animal Control. She graduated from McEwan University & has a passion for animal welfare & investigating animal cruelty.
